That must be a lot of work.

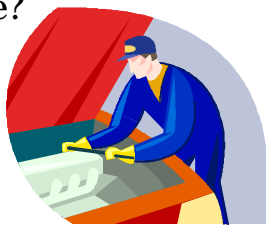
Bernie: It is. Everyday I fix cars.
