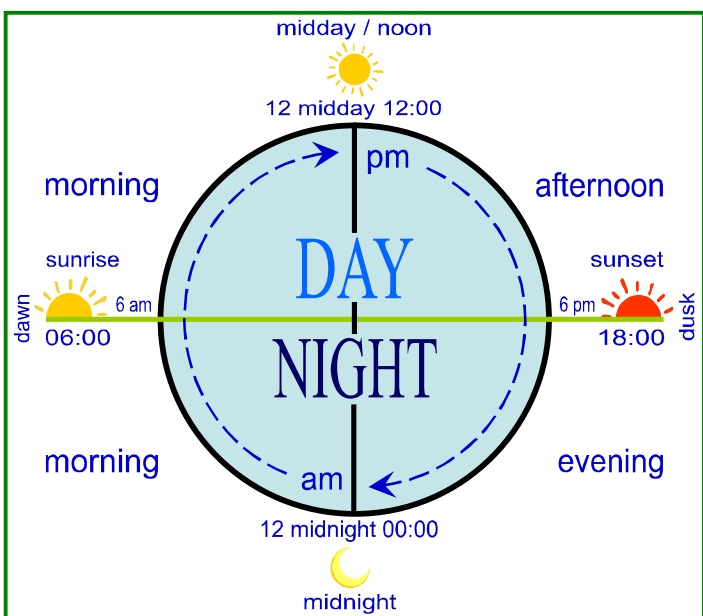

What are Conjunctions?

1. New Words

The 7 important parts of the day:



1. **MIDNIGHT** = middle of the night (00:00 hours).
2. **MIDDAY** = middle of the day; "NOON" (12:00 hours).
3. **MORNING** = from midnight to midday
4. **AFTERNOON** = from midday (noon) to evening (12:00 hours to 18:00 hours/6:00 pm)
5. **EVENING** = from the end of the afternoon to midnight (18:00 hours/6:00 pm to 00:00 hours)
6. **DAWN** = sunrise
7. **DUSK** = sunset

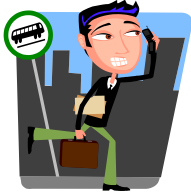

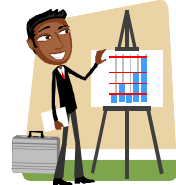
