

What are Conjunctions?

The 7 important parts of the day:



- 1. **MIDNIGHT** = middle of the night (00:00 hours).
- 2. MIDDAY = middle of the day; "NOON" (12:00 hours).
- 3. **MORNING** = from midnight to midday
- **AFTERNOON** = from midday (noon) to evening (12:00 hours to 18:00 hours/6:00 pm)
- **5. EVENING** = from the end of the afternoon to midnight (18:00 hours/6:00 pm to 00:00 hours)
- **6. DAWN** = sunrise
- 7. DUSK = sunset
